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**PART 1**  
**GENERAL REGULATIONS**

**§ 15-101. Definitions and Interpretation. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. Words and phrases, when used in this chapter, except for sections or Parts to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81), as amended, except that, in this chapter, the word "street" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.
2. The term "legal holidays," as used in this chapter, shall mean and include: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
3. In this chapter, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine.
4. Although the streets in the Township run generally in a northeast, southwest and a northwest-southeast direction, for the purpose of this chapter, Oxford Road and Hanover Street and the streets running parallel or generally parallel to Oxford Road and Hanover Street shall be deemed to run in a north-south direction, and U.S. Route 30 and the streets parallel or generally parallel to U.S. Route 30 shall be deemed to run in an east-west direction.

**§ 15-102. Manner of Adopting Permanent Traffic and Parking Regulations. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

All traffic and parking regulations of a permanent nature shall be enacted as ordinances, as parts of ordinances, as amendments to ordinances, or as amendments to this chapter, except where the law specifically authorizes less formal action.

**§ 15-103. Provisions to be Continuation of Existing Regulations. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The provisions of this chapter, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this chapter, are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations, and not as new enactments. Nothing in this chapter shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any of those repealed or superseded ordinances or regulations.

**§ 15-104. Temporary and Emergency Regulations. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. The Chief of Police shall have the following powers to regulate traffic and parking temporarily and in time of emergency:
  - A. In the case of fire, flood, storm or other emergency, to establish temporary traffic and/or parking regulations.
  - B. In the case of emergency or to facilitate public works, or in the conduct of parades, processions or public events, to restrict or prohibit traffic and/or parking in limited areas for periods of not more than 72 hours.
2. Such temporary and emergency regulations shall be enforced by the EARP in the same manner as permanent regulations. Any person who shall operate or park a vehicle or tractor in violation of any such regulations, or who shall move, remove, destroy, injure or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made to give notice of any such regulation, shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalty set forth in the law or elsewhere in this chapter for a violation of such nature, and, in case of a violation for which no specific penalty is set forth in the law or elsewhere in this chapter, to a fine of not more than \$25 together with costs of prosecution.

**§ 15-105. Experimental Regulations. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The Board of Supervisors may, from time to time by resolution, designate places upon and along the highways in the Township where, for a period of not more than 90 days, specific traffic and/or parking regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be in force and effect, and shall designate such locations by proper signs and markings. Such regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be effective as if they had been specified in this chapter. No person shall operate or park a vehicle or tractor in violation of any such regulation, prohibition or restriction, and no person shall move, remove, destroy or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made by authority of this section. Any person who shall violate any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalty set forth in the law or elsewhere in this chapter for a violation of such nature, and in case of a violation for which no specific penalty is set forth in the law or elsewhere in this chapter, to a fine of not more than \$25 together with costs of prosecution; provided, the purpose of this section is to allow for the test and experimental determination of the feasibility and desirability of permanent changes in the ordinances of the Township relative to traffic and parking.

**§ 15-106. Traffic on Streets Closed or Restricted for Construction, Maintenance or Special Events. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. The Board of Supervisors shall have authority to close any street or specific part of a street to vehicular traffic and to place barriers or station police officers at each end of the closed portion, while construction or maintenance work is under way or a special event is being conducted on the closed

portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such closed portion.

2. The Board of Supervisors shall have authority to establish a restricted traffic area upon any street where construction or maintenance work is under way and to station flagmen at each end of the restricted portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such restricted traffic area at any time when the flagman is displaying a sign directing that vehicle to stop, or is signaling that vehicle, by a flag or other device, not to proceed.
3. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25 and costs.

**§ 15-107. Use of Streets by Processions and Assemblages. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. For the purpose of this section, the words "assemblage" and "procession" shall have the following meanings:

ASSEMBLAGE — A gathering of people without vehicles, which interferes with the movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic on any street.

PROCESSION — A group of individuals, vehicles, animals and/or objects moving along a street in a way that interferes with the normal movement of traffic. A procession shall not include a funeral caravan or military convoy.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to hold or participate in any assemblage unless the person organizing or conducting the assemblage first obtains a permit from the Township Secretary, which shall be issued without fee. Application for the permit shall be made at least one week in advance of the day on which the assemblage is proposed to be held, but in any case where a state-designated highway is proposed to be used, application shall be made at least three weeks in advance of the proposed date. The permit shall state the place where and the date when the assemblage is to be held, the hour when the assemblage may convene and the hour by which it shall have been completely dispersed. It shall be unlawful for any person to hold or to participate in any assemblage unless the permit has been granted, or at any time or place other than that authorized by the permit.
3. It shall be unlawful for any person to hold or participate in any procession unless the person organizing or conducting the procession first obtains a permit from the Township Secretary, which shall be issued without fee. Application for the permit shall be made at least two weeks in advance of the day when the procession is proposed to be held, but in any case where a state-designated highway is proposed to be used, application shall be made at least three weeks in advance of the proposed date. The permit shall specify the date on which the procession is to be held, the route to be followed by the procession, the hour when and place where participants may commence to assemble and form before the procession is under way, the time

when the procession may commence to move along its route, and the time by which the end of the procession shall have reached the end of the route of the procession and the procession shall have been disbanded. It shall be unlawful for any person to hold or to participate in any procession unless the permit shall have been granted, or under any conditions as to time or route or otherwise than those stated in the permit.

4. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25 and costs.

**§ 15-108. Authority of Police Officers. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The EARP are hereby given authority to direct traffic on the highways of the Township and at intersections thereof.

**§ 15-109. Authorization for Use of Speed Timing Devices. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. The EARP is hereby authorized to use all speed timing devices for the determination of speed of a motor vehicle as are approved or will be approved by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3368.
2. This section authorizes the use of said devices upon all highways within the Township, be they Township, county or state highways, and does also hereby elect to exercise all powers granted to "local authorities" under the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 6101 et seq., as hereafter amended, supplemented, modified or reenacted by the General Assembly of Pennsylvania.

PART 2

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

**§ 15-201. Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2-1992, 9/15/1992, § 1; by Ord. 1/3/1994A, § A; by Ord. 11/1/1994, § A; by Ord. 12/-/1999A, § 1; by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1; and by Ord. 2006-50, 2/21/2006, § 1]**

Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

**§ 15-202. Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Bridges and Elevated Structures. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1]**

Maximum speed limits are established, as follows, on certain bridges and elevated structures, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any such bridge or elevated structure, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that bridge or elevated structure:

**§ 15-203. Maximum Speed Limits Established for Certain Vehicles on Hazardous Grades. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1]**

The following are declared to be hazardous grades, and, upon any such hazardous grade, no person shall drive a vehicle, having a gross weight in excess of that referred to for that grade, in the direction stated for that grade, at a speed in excess of that established in this section for that grade, and, if so stated for a particular grade, the driver of every such vehicle shall stop the vehicle before proceeding downhill:

**§ 15-212. Through Highways Established. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1]**

The following highways are established as through highways, thus authorizing stop or yield signs to be erected facing traffic approaching every intersection with the through highway except for those intersections with traffic signals, or with exceptions or modifications as indicated below. Every driver of a vehicle approaching a stop or yield sign authorized by this section shall stop the vehicle or yield right-of-way as required by § 3323(b) or 3323(c) of the Vehicle Code, as the case may be, and shall not proceed into or across the through highway until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

**§ 15-213. Stop Intersections Established. The following intersections (in addition to intersections with the through highways established by § 15-212) are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face

traffic approaching the second-named street (the intersecting or through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by § 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second-named or intersecting or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or yield street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall slow down or stop the vehicle as required by § 3323(c) of the Vehicle Code, and then yield the right-of-way as required by that subsection of the Vehicle Code.

GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS

**§ 15-401. Vehicles to be Parked Within Marked Spaces. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

Wherever a space is marked off on any street for the parking of an individual vehicle, every vehicle parked there shall be parked wholly within the lines bounding that space, and it shall be a violation of this Part for any person to park a vehicle or allow it to remain parked otherwise.

**§ 15-402. Angle Parking Required on Portions of Certain Streets. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

1. Only angle parking shall be permitted on the following portions of streets:

**§ 15-409. Penalties. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1; and by Ord. 2015-104, 11/17/2015]**

Any person who violates any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine as set by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Oxford Township from time to time, plus costs; provided that it shall be the duty of the police officers of the Eastern Adams Regional Police Department or other police

officers as may be duly authorized by the Board of Supervisors of Oxford Township and of parking enforcement personnel of the Township to report to the appropriate official all violations of any provision of this Part, indicating, in each case: the section violated; the license number of the vehicle involved in the violation; the location where the violation took place; and any other facts that might be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending the violation. The police officer or other person making the report shall also attach to or place upon every such vehicle a notice stating that the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part. The notice shall contain instructions to the owner or driver of the vehicle that if he will report to the Township Office and pay the sum of \$25 within 120 hours after the time of the notice, or if he will place the sum of \$25 in the mail addressed to the Township Office within 120 hours, that act will save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs prescribed in the first sentences of this section.



PART 5

**REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDMENT OF ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES**

**§ 15-501. Applicability and Scope. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

This Part is enacted under authority of § 6109(a-22) of the Vehicle Code<sup>1</sup> and gives authority to the Township to remove and impound those vehicles which are parked in a tow away zone and in violation of parking regulations of this chapter. Vehicles which have been abandoned (as defined by the Vehicle Code) or which are parked in such a manner as to interfere with traffic or pose a hazard to others, may be towed under the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

**§ 15-502. Authority to Remove and Impound. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The Township shall have authority to remove and impound, or to order the removal and impounding, of any vehicle parked overtime or otherwise illegally, provided that the circumstances of its parking were within the conditions stated in § 15-501 of this Part, provided that no such vehicle shall be removed or impounded except in strict adherence to the provisions of this Part or the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

**§ 15-503. Tow-Away Zones Designated. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The following designated streets and/or parking lots are hereby established as tow-away zones. Signs shall be posted to place the public on notice that their vehicles may be towed for violation of the Township parking regulations:

**§ 15-504. Payment of Towing and Storage Charges. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The payment of towing and storage charges shall not relieve the owner or driver of any vehicle from liability for any fine or penalty for the violation of the provision of this chapter for which the vehicle was removed or impounded.

**§ 15-505. Reclamation Costs. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

In order to reclaim his vehicle, the owner shall pay towing and storage costs, plus a \$25 fee, of which \$10 shall be transferred to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation by the garage to which the vehicle was taken.

**§ 15-506. Records of Vehicles Removed and Impounded. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

The Township shall cause a record to be kept of all vehicles impounded under this Part and shall be able at all reasonable times to furnish the owners or the agents of

the owners of those vehicles with information as to the place of storage of the vehicle.

**§ 15-507. Restrictions upon Removal of Vehicles. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

No vehicle shall be removed under the authority of this Part or the Vehicle Code if, at the time of the intended removal, the owner or the person for the time being in charge of the vehicle is present and expresses a willingness and intention to remove the vehicle immediately.

**§ 15-508. Penalty. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1]**

Penalties will be as provided in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

**§ 15-509. Reports and Disposition of Unclaimed Vehicles. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990]**

If, after a period of 15 days, the vehicle in storage remains unclaimed, a report shall be filed with PennDOT, in accordance with § 15-7311 of the Vehicle Code, by the person having legal custody of the vehicle. If the vehicle has not been claimed after 30 days, the vehicle may be transferred to a licensed salvor, who will then be responsible for filing the proper reports and disposing of the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 73 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 et seq., as amended).

PART 6

**SNOW EMERGENCY**

**§ 15-601. Declaration of Snow and Ice Emergency. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 10/5/1993, § D]**

In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in § 15-603 of this Part, a snow and ice emergency is declared whenever there shall be an accumulation of two or more inches of snow on said routes.

**§ 15-602. Parking Prohibited, Driving Motor Vehicles Restricted, on Snow Emergency Routes During Emergency. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 10/5/1993, § D]**

After any snow emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful at any time during the continuance of the emergency for any person to park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route designated in § 15-603 of this Part.

**§ 15-604. Enforcement. [Added by Ord. 2015-102, 9/9/2015]**

1. The Police Department within the Township's jurisdiction or the Township's Code Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to have any motor vehicle

parked in violation of § 15-6020 of this Part towed away at the expense of the owner of said vehicle.

2. The Board of Supervisors or its designee is hereby authorized to barricade any street and redirect traffic whenever necessary to plow or clear or otherwise remove snow. It shall be unlawful for any person to bypass or run through or over any such barricade. For purposes of this section, "barricade" shall mean any object visible for a distance of 100 feet in clear weather that is used to block off an area of the street.
3. The Police Department within the Township's jurisdiction or the Township's Code Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to issue a notice of violation or citation in an amount set forth in § 15-605 to any vehicle parked in violation of § 15-602.

**§ 15-605. Penalties for Violation. [Ord. 71, 3/6/1990; as amended by Ord. 10/5/1993, § D; by Ord. 2003-31, 10/21/2003, § 1; by Ord. 2015-102, 9/9/2015; and by Ord. No. 2018-115, 5/14/2018]**

Enforcement against any violation of the provisions of this Part shall be brought before a District Magistrate in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. Upon conviction, a violator shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$50 for each violation, recoverable with costs, including the costs for towing and storing the vehicle(s), or imprisonment to the extent allowed by law for the punishment of summary offenses, or both. Each day that the violation continues shall be a separate offense.
